<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The nurse learner has an enhanced understanding that mental health issues are a lifelong illness and without early intervention and sustained and continuous treatment, the likelihood of recovery will continue to be stifled. The ridiculous “merry go round” cycle for the individual will ensue for decades, often resulting in poor outcomes. i.e., repetitive incarceration, suicide, death, early mortality.
